Purpose:

The Information Technology Services Division in the Computing and Computational Sciences Directorate at the Oak Ridge National Laboratory (ORNL) seeks to hire a Web Analyst/Developer to independently design, develop, and maintain ORNL websites, as well as provide instruction and support for users of new web tools and resources.

Major Duties/Responsibilities:

Typical projects to be supported range from simple to highly complex for a large (2000+ employee) enterprise environment. It is not uncommon for multiple websites and customers to be supported simultaneously by a single analyst, so the ability to work independently, manage time effectively, and be goal and deadline oriented is required. Projects to be supported may include new SharePoint websites which span all phases of the software development lifecycle from requirements gathering through production implementation. Other project possibilities include maintenance and enhancement of existing websites using various other technologies.

Qualifications Minimum Qualifications Required:

This position requires competence in all phases of web site and software development including requirements gathering and analysis, system design, prototype development, website design, configuration control, testing, software quality assurance, and website maintenance.

- JavaScript/JQuery


The following skills are considered a plus, but not required:
