What will I be doing?

- Participating in the evaluation of courses and programs from civilian educational and training institutions and observe the training of program managers assigned to the Academic Affairs division
- Observing the education counselors during quality assurance of student records prior to graduation and review of student progression throughout the programs
- Obtaining knowledge of compliance requirements with college directives and being able to identify appropriate training
- In cooperation with counselors, assist clients assess their values, interests, abilities and skills
 and relate these to opportunities for employment, education, training and life skills

What is the anticipated start date?
