### Description



OREM carries out the mission using sound business practices, innovative management approaches, and science and technology to reduce risks and costs within the EM regulatory framework.

The Multimedia Fellow will engage with efforts to enhance our organization's engagement and reach on social media which will involve repackaging and re-editing stories from our newscast to a format more engaging for social media.
