Description The Department of Defense (DoD) is offering students currently pursuing or recently received a Bachelor's, Master's or Doctoral degree internships or fellowships at the Defense Healthcare Management Systems (DHMS) PEO. Degree must have been received within two years of the appointment start date.

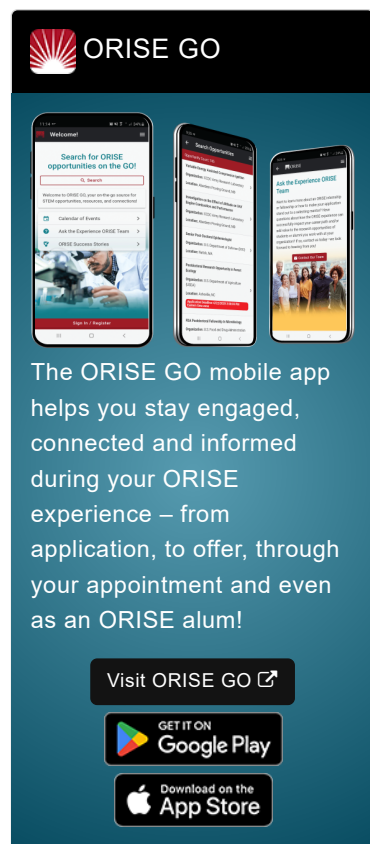
What is the appointment length?

This appointment is a three-month research appointment, with the possibility to be renewed for additional research periods. Appointments may be extended depending on funding availability, project assignment, program rules, and availability of the participant.
