What will I be doing?

As an Oak Ridge Institute for Science and Education (ORISE) participant, you will join a community of scientists and researchers in an effort to support the research development test & evaluation of individual and groups serving combat rations.

Why should I apply?

Under the guidance of a mentor, you will gain hands-on experience to complement your education and support your academic and professional goals. Along the way, you will engage in activities and research within the CFD ration sensory evaluation program. You will gain experience in various Project Officers daily operational rations (OPRATs) tasks including:

- Maintaining organization and proper storage of OPRATs sensory evaluation samples.
- Analyzing Defense Working Capital Fund (DWCF) Engineering Support cases within Product Data Management Model Initiative (PDMI).
- Collaborating on creation of sensory reports.
- · Collecting and analyzing results of OPRAT storage studies.
- Collecting nutritional data from analysis programs and or analytical reports.
- Participating in the order process for individual and group ration components and ration systems.
- Collaborating with PO's on CFD production tests, ration assembly and Initial Operational Test & Evaluation preparation.

Where will I be located?

Natick, Massachusetts

What is the anticipated start date?

Exact start dates will be determined at the time of selection and in coordination with the selected candidate. Applications are reviewed on an ongoing basis and internships or fellowships will be filled as qualified candidates are identified.

What is the appointment length?

Appointments are initially for one year with the option to extend the
