**What is the appointment length?**

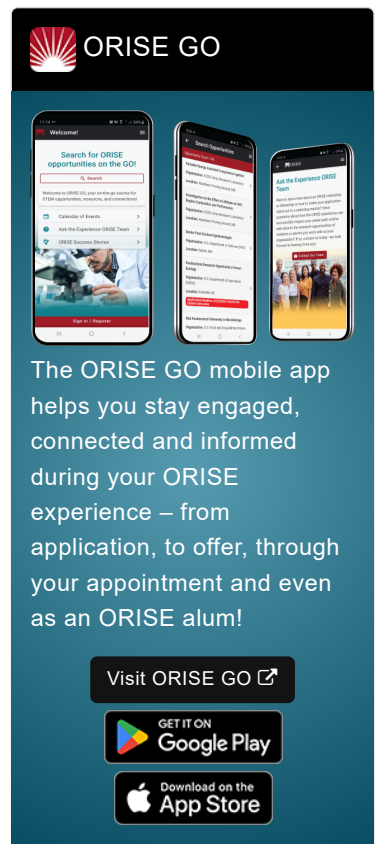
