The Air Force Research Laboratory is offering a summer internship in Team Enhancement, Assessment, and Measurement (TEAM) research at the Wright-Patterson Air Force Base.

What will I be doing?

As an Oak Ridge Institute for Science and Education (ORISE) participant, you will join a community of scientists and researchers in an effort to generate capabilities that accurately assess contextualized team performance and assures continually optimized decision-making in distributed, multi-mixed teams (human-human and human-machine teams; teams and teams-of-teams). Air Force strategic planning documents envision that future missions will require complex, distributed, and potentially, ad hoc teaming to be successful. In this future, there will be a critical need to dynamically monitor and assess teamwork for breakdowns that could interfere with achievement of mission goals.

Why should I apply?

Under the guidance of a mentor, you will gain hands-on experience to complement your education and support your academic and professional goals. Along the way, you will engage in activities and research in several areas. These include, but are not limited to:

- Planning, executing, and publishing Air Force-relevant research with a focus on human-human and human-machine teaming
- Research data collection
- · Protocol writing and institutional review board approval
- Completing advance literature searches
- Collaborating with other organizations and scientists to effectively complete research objectives
- Aiding in the development of future grant applications and protocols

Dayton, Ohio


What is the anticipated start date?
