Description The U.S. Army Garrison-Italy (USAG-Italy) in coordination with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) is offering an internship in engineering and project management at the USAG-Italy facility in Vicenza, Italy.

What will I be doing?

As an ORISE participant, you will join a community of scientists and researchers in an effort to evaluate construction costs and compare with budgeted amounts. Projects that will be evaluated include but are not limited to family housing, airfields, communications systems, hospitals, medical clinics, ammunition storage facilities, and facilities modernization projects located in Vicenza, Italy.

Why should I apply?

Under the guidance of a mentor, you will engage in a variety of research activities, including:

- Developing visual aids and presentations of USACE construction projects
- Analyzing initial project schedules versus actual project duration
- Evaluating cost drivers in construction projects
- Engaging with contracting officers and teams responsible for the administration of construction projects
- Gaining insights on the complex nature of administering US Government construction projects
- Observing and learning about active construction projects

What is the anticipated start date?

Exact start dates will be determined at the time of selection and in coordination with the selected candidate. Applications are reviewed on an ongoing basis and internships or fellowships will be filled as qualified candidates are identified by USAG-Italy staff.

What is the appointment length?

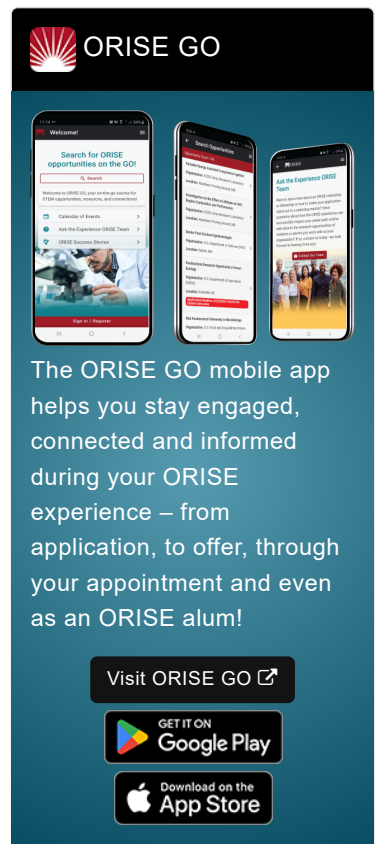

U.S. military veterans who have been honorably discharged (or who have been medically discharged because of a service-connected disability) and who have received a degree in an eligible discipline within ten years of the desired start date are also eligible.
