- · Prepare graphs, tables, and other illustrative devices for the visual presentation of data
- Collaborate with military police and law enforcement professionals
- Create and maximize use of digital platforms to design, develop, and deploy automated workflows
- Utilize systems to query and report structure for displaying statistics from monthly/annual Dispatch data
- Optimize data entry procedures for DES shift log and Dispatch CFS Index
