The DOE Scholars Program provides stipends starting at \$750 per week for undergraduate students and \$950 per week for graduate students and recent graduates for full time participation. Part-time appointments may be possible.

Travel

Travel reimbursement of inbound and outbound costs up to \$1,000 for participants who live more than fifty miles, one-way, from the assigned hosting site.

Length of Appointment

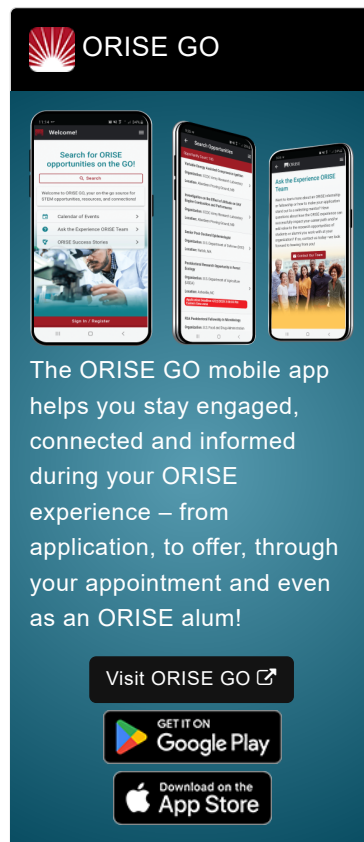
Appointments may vary in length depending on the project assignment.

Documents must have all social security numbers, student identification numbers, and/or dates of birth removed (blanked out, blackened out, made illegible, etc.) prior to uploading into the application system.

- **Academic/Professional Recommendation** - You are encouraged to request a recommendation from a professional who can speak to your abilities and potential for success as well as your scientific capabilities and personal characteristics. Recommenders will be asked to complete a recommendation in Zintellect. **Recommendations are due 9/29/2025 8:00:00 AM Eastern Time Zone.**

All documents must be submitted via Zintellect. All application components **must** be received in the system in order to be considered.

The participant will not enter into an employee/employer relationship with ORISE, ORAU, DOE, or any other office or agency. Instead, the participant will be affiliated with ORISE for the administration of the appointment through the ORISE appointment letter and Terms of Appointment.
