Description The U.S. Army Garrison-Italy (USAG-Italy) is offering a student or postgraduate student internship at a USAG-Italy facility.

What will I be doing?

As an ORISE participant, you will join a community of scientists and mission support personnel to learn the full OHS surveying process, gaining experience with equipment calibration, field study and collection, analysis requisitions, and report writing. You will participate in project groups and the SOHAC semi-annually to provide updates and visibility to senior leaders.

Why should I apply?

Under the guidance of a mentor, you will engage in a variety of research activities, including:

- Performing a confined space inventory audit
- Developing visual safety aids and training materials
- Developing personnel protective equipment and machine tool guarding guides and standard operating procedures
- Developing analysis, research resources, then develop and ensure implementation of Traffic Safety Program
- Developing Installation level radiation protection program
- Researching and developing courses of action for effective explosive management program

What is the anticipated start date?

Exact start dates will be determined at the time of selection and in coordination with the selected candidate. Applications are reviewed on an ongoing basis and internships will be filled as qualified candidates are identified.

What is the appointment length?

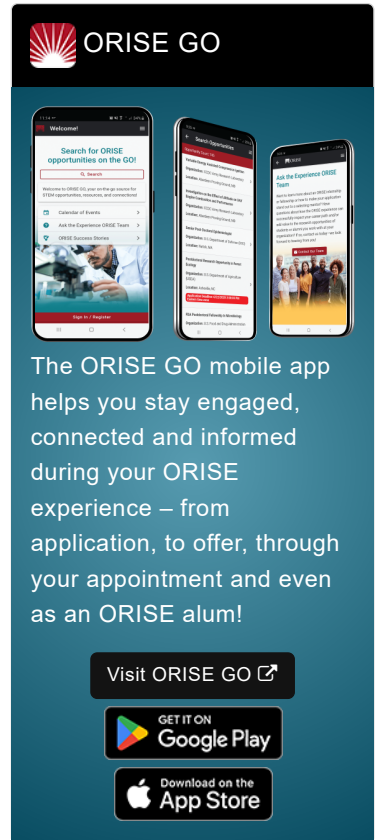
