Description The Air Force Research Laboratory (AFRL) Cognition and Modeling Branch is offering a Research Fellowship at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio.

What will I be doing?

As an Oak Ridge Institute for Science and Education (ORISE) participant, you will join a community of scientists and researchers in an effort to conduct experiment(s) that provide insight into questions such as, but not limited to, the neurocognitive degradation that could occur to C-130 crew members from extended exposure to environmental insults. This research will also inform the development of effective human-machine systems and healthy Airmen protocol and guidelines. It may involve the use of physiological measures such as eye-tracking and electroencephalogram.

Why should I apply?

Under the guidance of a mentor, you will gain hands-on experience to complement your education and support your academic and professional goals. Along the way, you will engage in activities and research in several areas. These include, but are not limited to:

- Participating in team-based research efforts, such as designing and conducting experiments and performing data analysis
- Gaining experience with the design of rigorous experimental paradigms, experimental software development, institution review board protocol(s), and data collection
- Learning about new domain(s) relevant to the Cognition and Modeling Branch at Wright-Patterson AFB
- Reporting research updates in individual and group meetings
- Sharing research findings through publications and presentations

What is the anticipated start date?

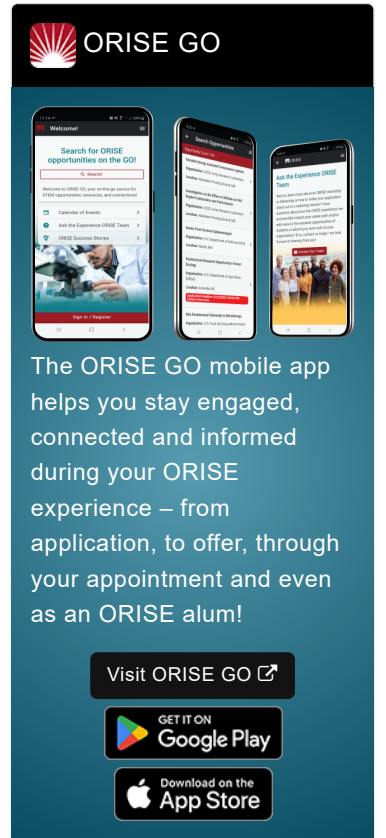
