Description:

Venus is called Earth's hellish twin – being a similar size and bulk composition to the Earth, but with caustic near surface conditions. It is shrouded in a thick opaque cloud deck obscuring the surface from most orbital measurements. Therefore, we know little about the exact composition and mineralogy of the crust of Venus or how the crust interacts with the caustic atmosphere causing progressive weathering and alteration.

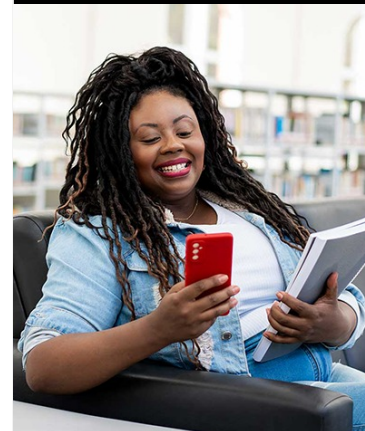
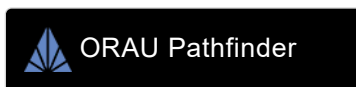
