**Description** The Air Force Institute of Technology is offering a 2026 internships at Wright Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio.

**What will I be doing?**

As an ORISE participant, you will join a community of scientists and researchers in their efforts to investigate the interactions of radiation with a wide range of materials such as nuclear fuels/cladding, radiation detectors, and Air Force air crew. Selected candidates will study the fundamental physics involved and explore the connections to Air Force related applications. Computational tools will be used to simulate and deepen understanding of these interactions. The selected candidates will then participate in interpreting the effects of the simulations to assess impact on applications.

**Why should I apply?**

Under the guidance of a mentor, you will gain hands-on experience to complement your education and support your academic and professional goals. Along the way, you will engage in activities and research in several areas. These include, but are not limited to:

- Relate fundamental nuclear physics and engineering concepts to Air Force applications and experimental data
- Gain experience with computational simulations of radiation interactions and subsequent effects
- Learn to communicate results to the broader AFIT and scientific communities via written reports, poster presentations, and/or oral presentations

**Where will I be located?**

Dayton, Ohio

**What is the anticipated start date?**

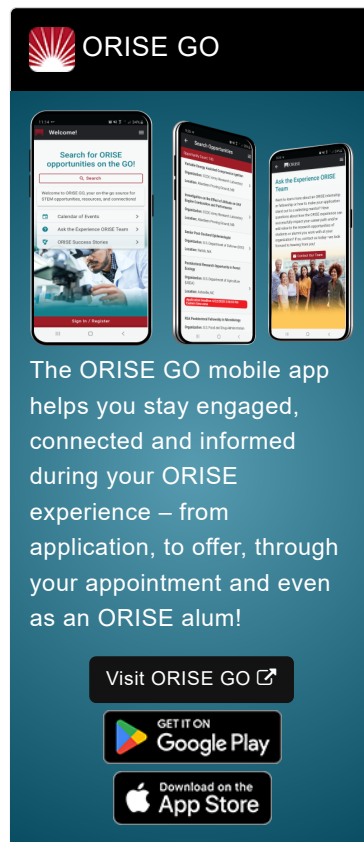
Exact start dates determined at the time of selection and in coordination with the selected candidate. Applications are reviewed on an ongoing basis and internships will be filled as qualified candidates are identified.

**What is the appointment length?**

Research interns are typically appointed for a term of 10 weeks, with the possibility to be renewed for additional periods. Appointments may be extended depending on funding availability, project assignment, program rules, and availability of the participant.

**What are the provisions?**

You will receive a stipend to be determined by AFIT. Stipends are typically based on a participant's



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academic standing, discipline, experience, and research facility location. Other provisions may include the following:

- Health Insurance Supplement (*Participants are eligible to purchase health insurance through ORISE*)
- Relocation Allowance
- Training and Travel Allowance
