Description The U.S. Army Garrison - Italy is offering an internship at Vicenza, Italy or Camp Darby.

What will I be doing?

As an ORISE participant, you will join a community of scientists and researchers in an effort to measure and report command information effectiveness on web and social media platforms as a key component to public communication.

Why should I apply?

Under the guidance of a mentor, you will gain hands-on experience to complement your education and support your academic and professional goals. Along the way, you will engage in learning activities and research in several areas. These include, but are not limited to:

- Assess metrics measured from data gathered in social media insights and website analytics
- Create weekly reports
- Consolidate feedback from community members using surveys and other anecdotal collection methods
- Merge empirical evidence gathered from web/social media analytics
- Study data associated with content
- Gain experience in the creation of multimedia content for a variety of online and social media platforms
- Learn technical aspects of photo and video production/editing and web/social media posting

Where will I be located? Vicenza, Italy or Camp Darby

What is the anticipated start date?

Exact start dates will be determined at the time of selection and in coordination with the selected candidate. Applications are reviewed on an ongoing basis and internships or fellowships will be filled as qualified candidates are identified.

What is the appointment length?

This appointment is a six-month research appointment, with the possibility to be renewed for additional research periods. Appointments may be extended depending on funding availability, project assignment, program rules, and availability of the participant.

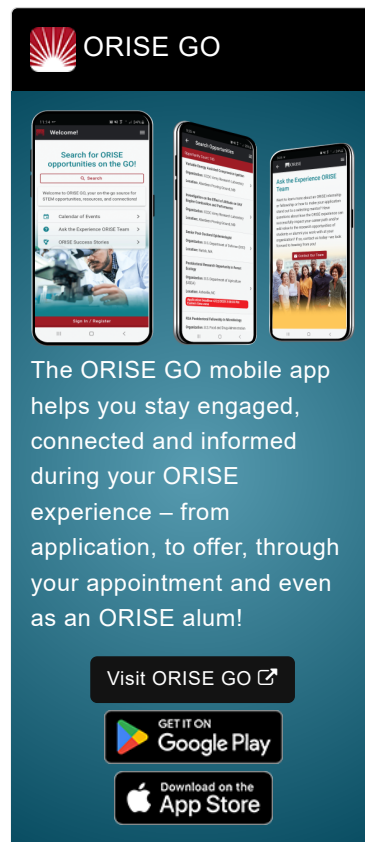
What are the appointment provisions?

You will receive a stipend to be determined by USAG-Italy. Stipends are typically based on a participant's academic standing, discipline, experience, and research facility location. Other provisions may include the following:
