Description In order to promote research and utilize the unique partnership between Oak Ridge National Lab (ORNL) and the University of Tennessee (UT), the Office of Undergraduate Research at the UT Knoxville campus funds multiple summer internships for its undergraduates. The UTK/ORNL Higher Education Research Experiences (HERE) Summer Internship Program is a 10-week, full-time internship that provides students with research projects in a variety of STEM disciplines at ORNL. Students will learn under the direction of ORNL research staff at either ORNL's main campus, Hardin Valley campus, or ORNL research related facilities on the UT Knoxville campus. Upon the completion of the internship, students are required to submit and present a poster in the summer poster session and present their research at UT Knoxville Discovery Day in the fall. Successful applicants are placed into labs that best fit their research area of interest in one of five research divisions at ORNL:

- Computing and Computational Sciences
- Energy and Environmental Sciences
- Neutron Sciences
- Nuclear Science and Engineering
- Physical Sciences

Participants may also be considered for National Security Sciences.
