Duration: Full-time or part-time appointments of up to one year, renewable up to four additional years. This is not a summer internship.


Deadline(s): applications accepted on a year-round basis.

Benefits: Salary based on academic level or degree; benefits of full-time or part-time temporary employees of Oak Ridge Associated Universities. Depending on the availability of funding, participants enrolled in an undergraduate course of study may be eligible for tuition and fees reimbursement.

 - Possess a skill set relevant to laboratory need (e.g. AMTEK or Mechatronics certification), OR have an associate's degree or higher in a relevant field
 - No GPA requirement
 - Not be enrolled in a graduate course of study
