Description The EPA Environmental Research and Business Support Program has immediate openings for three (3) part-time 20 hours per week Student Laboratory Support positions with the EPA's Office of Research and Development's Center Hill Facility in Cincinnati, OH.

### What the EPA project is about

The Office of Research and Development at the EPA supports high-quality research to improve the scientific basis for decisions on national environmental issues and help EPA achieve its environmental goals. Research is conducted in a broad range of environmental areas by scientists in EPA laboratories and at universities across the country.

The US Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Office of Research and Development (ORD) Land Remediation Pollution Control Division has been charged with conducting research in the area of solid waste containment and disposal including the examination and evaluation of new technologies such as bioreactor landfills. Municipal solid waste landfill owners are required to submit data to the State's regulatory body. The data includes leachate volume and quality. There is an increasing need for the EPA to gather that data to understand long term performance.

### What you will be doing

As a part-time team member, you will assist the solid waste research team with data collection/entry, laboratory analysis and experimental upkeep.
